Parking Patterns

- Increase of cars parking “south of the border”
- Decrease of cars in many parts of Downtown North
- Other?



Rollout Update

- About ~150 notices left on car windshields for first day of enforcement (September 15)
- Increase in parking citations issued in Downtown core
- Permits Sold:
 - BUS (Business standard): 578
 - BVR (Business reduced price): 318
 - RES (Resident): 2,847
 - TOTAL PERMITS SOLD: 3,743
- On-Site customer service for through September 24; will monitor moving forward
